

AGENCY COMMITTEES

The Medford Urban Renewal Agency's committees were formed to broaden public participation in the downtown renewal process. Committee members are appointed by the Agency Board, and serve three-year terms, with no term limits. The Budget, Marketing, Parking and Downtown Design Committees serve as advisory groups to the Medford Urban Renewal Agency. The Agency encourages and welcomes citizen interest by means of membership on any of its committees.

The Parking Committee meets the second Wednesday of every month at 8:00 a.m., at Medford Urban Renewal Agency 45 S. Holly St., Medford, OR 97501

AGENCY PARKING COMMITTEE

The **PARKING COMMITTEE** is an advisory committee to the Medford Urban Renewal Agency Board of Directors. It is served by seven public participants, as well as an Agency Staff member and a Parking Management Staff member. The Committee is responsible for the recommendation of policy and plans for the provision and management of on-street and off-street public parking within the downtown area, consistent with the *City Center Vision Plan*.

Residency, employment, or business or property ownership within the Central Business District is a requirement for serving on the Parking Committee.

AGENCY PURPOSE

In 1988 the citizens of Medford recognized that if something was not done, they would soon lose their downtown. The character of downtown was quickly changing, as major retail stores, private and government offices, and entertainment uses began moving to newly developed fringe areas of the City. Over the years, the downtown's position, both as a regional center and the City's center, was slowly eroding away. The challenge was to recognize the dynamics of this change and to begin the reinvention and revitalization of downtown as a regional center for government, business, entertainment and culture. Today, through the efforts of the citizens of Medford, the foresight of the City Council, and the commitment of the Urban Renewal Agency Committees, Board and Staff, the process of reinventing our downtown is well under way.

Commonly Asked Questions

- Q. How often does the Parking Committee meet?*
- A. Typically, the Parking Committee meets the second Wednesday of each month in the Agency Conference Room.*
- Q. Are Committee members reminded of meeting dates?*
- A. Prior to every meeting, members are sent an agenda. Members are also given a courtesy reminder call or sent an email..*
- Q. How often do openings become available on the Parking Committee?*
- A. Committee appointments are for 3-year terms with no term limits. The Agency advertises positions as they become available, and contacts interested citizens whose names are on file.*
